

The aim of Pan African University is to develop institutions of excellence in science, technology, innovation, social sciences and governance, which would constitute the bedrock for an Africa pool of higher education and research.

MISSION AND SCOPE OF PAU

To realize the strategic vision, six missions have been assigned to the PAU: Develop continental-wide and world-class graduate and post-graduate programmes in science, technology, innovation, human and social sciences

- Stimulate collaboration, internationally competitive, cutting-edge fundamental and development oriented research, in areas having a direct bearing on the technical, economic and social development of Africa
- Enhance the mobility of students, lecturers, researchers and administrative staff between African universities to improve on teaching, leadership, and collaborative research
- Contribute to the capacity building of present and future Africa Union stakeholders
- Enhance the attractiveness of African higher education and research institutions for effective development and retention of young African talent, while attracting the best intellectual capital from across the globe, including the African diaspora
- Invigorate dynamic and productive partnership with public and private sectors



Pan African University Pan Africaine

The advent of the African Union in 2000 as by product of the defunct Organization of African Unity witnessed a rethinking of Africa's development agenda and strategy, focusing more on the acceleration of the continent's political and economic integration. At the center of new continental priorities is the promotion of research in all fields, in particular science and technology. The Assembly of Heads of State and Government of the African Union therefore made a decision to establish the Pan African University (PAU) in 2010, and on 14 December 2011, the AUC launched PAU as a flagship continental initiative. The University's Statute was adopted by the Assembly in January 2013.

The PAU was inspired and driven by major policy frameworks of the AUC, including the vision of the African Union, the Second Decade of Education, and the Consolidated Plan of Action for Science and Technology. Within the same policy frameworks, PAU is embedded as a major instrument of the implementation of Agenda 2063, the Science, Technology innovation Strategy for Africa (STISA 2024), the Plan of Action for the Second Decade of Education for Africa which will give way to the African Continental Education Strategy; as well as the African Common Position on post 2015 Sustainable Development Goals.

Mission of the PAU

PAU has the mission to strengthen African Higher education and research, address quality, intra-African collaboration, innovation and links with industry and social sector. PAU is also a response to the quest to produce a critical mass of high quality intellectual capital for Africa, and make African higher education and research attractive, globally competitive, and locally relevant, as well as serve as a model for quality education. PAU is a new generation university constituted from educational and research structures already in operation undelay with the idea of establishing world-class research institutes to provide quality education and research, attract leadership and talent, and promote international cooperation. PAU uses a network of such existing structures of five flagship institutes in critical academic areas addressing Af-rica's cross-cutting developmental issues, challenges and opportunities, mainly in Governance, regional integration water energy, science and tech-nology, health, agriculture, etc.

PAU Structure Governance

PAU operates under the direction of the AUC Department of Human Re-sources, Science and Technology, as one managed by a singular Rectorate, with a Senate supervised by a council. The University focuses on five the-matic areas, namely: Basic Sciences, Technology and innovation; Life and Earth Sciences (including Health and Agriculture), Governance, Humanities and Social Sciences; Energy and Water Sciences (including Climate Change); and Space Sciences. The thematic areas are assigned to institute hosted by existing Universities of excellence across Africa's five geographic regions as follows:

- 1. The Institute for Basic Sciences, Technology and Innovation (PAUSTI), hosted by the Jomo Kenyatta University of Agriculture and technology in Kenya (Eastern Africa)
- 2. The Institute for Life and Earth Sciences (including Health and Agri- culture (PAULESI), hosted by the University of Ibadan in Nigeria (Western Africa)
- 3. The Institute for Governance, Humanities and Social Science (PAUGHSS), hosted by the University of Yaounde II in Cameroon (Central Africa)
- 4. The Institute for Water and Energy Sciences (including Climate Change (PAUWES) hosted by the University of Tiemcen in Algeria (Northern Africa)
- 5. The Institute for Space Sciences (PAUSS) to be hosted by a University in the republic of South Africa (Souther Africa)

Each PAU institute is headed by a Director, Staff of PAU Institutes include academic and administrative staff, who work within Departments and other units related to teaching, research extension activities and administration. Each of the related Institute has a Board which is responsible for the supervision of the academic, administrative, and financial management of the institute.

Administration requirements to Masters of Science programs An applicant should satisfy any of the following requirements:

- i. Hold a minimum of Upper Second Class Honours of a Bachelors degree in the relevant field from a recognized University.
- ii. Any other qualification considered to be equivalent to (i) by the PAU Institute.

Duration

For regular students, the Master of Science course shall extend over a period of twenty-four (24) months. The Doctor of Philosophy course shall extend over a period of thirty-six (36) months.

Structure

- I. The Master of Science shall be done by course work, examination and dissertation.
- ii. A candidate shall take mandatory core course units and elective course units, as well as participate in seminars and internships if required in the curriculum
- iii. Except for the science courses, the second year of study shall be devoted to carrying out research, participating in seminars, and presentation of thesis.

General Regulation and Policies

Rules and regulation which apply to all PAU students include student discipline, examination regulations, extenuating circumstances, academic appeals and health and safety policy. Queries relating to the general regulations and procedures affecting students should be directed to the Academic Support Office. Students are ex-pected to display courteous behaviours and discipline at all times.

Matriculation and Orientation

All new students will be required to officially register at specific PAU Institute as part of a mandatory orientation program. A schedule of matriculation and orientat ion, outlining various activities, will be issued to each student at the time of registration.

Students admitted to various programs at PAU will also be register in each academic year of study at the beginning of the semester. Any Stu-dent who fails to register will be considered to have withdrawn. Such a student will lose all privileges including the scholarship. It is the respon-sibility of the student to confirm the exact dates for registration during each year.



Director's Speech

This yearbook comprises of photo album of top management, sponsors and the graduands of the fifth set of PhD students and sixth set of MSc. students at the Pan African University Institute for Life and Earth Sciences (including Health and Agriculture). A total of four PhD students and fifty master's students graduated on 16th and 17th November 2021.

The fifty-four students graduated from the ten programmes offered at PAULESI. Of the fifty master's students, there are six from Environmental Management, four each from Mineral Exploration Geoscience and Reproductive Biology, five each from Petroleum Geoscience, Plant Breeding, Reproductive Health, Vaccine Production and Quality Control, Sport Management and Policy Development and Medicinal Plant Research and Drug Development, and six from Avian Medicine. Of the four Doctor of Philosophy candidates, one student each from Petroleum Geoscience, Mineral Exploration, Plant Breeding and Reproductive Health.

A total of fourteen students hail from the host country, Nigeria, six from Kenya, four from Cameroon, three each from Democratic Republic of Congo, Ethiopia, Somalia, Rwanda and Zimbabwe, two each from Malawi, Ghana, Liberia and Guinea, one each from Swaziland, Burundi, Erithrea, Uganda, South Sudan, Sudan and Benin.

Across the fifty-four graduating students, there are twenty-nine females and twenty-five males. There is one female PhD graduand and twenty-eight female MSc. graduands. There are three male PhD graduands and twenty-two male MSc. graduands.

These graduating students have worked tirelessly to excel and achieve this feat in their career and we are so delighted with their

achievements. They have also been found worthy in character and learning and PAULESI is so profound of them. For some of these graduands, it was the first time they were stepping out of the borders of their home countries while for some, it was the first time experience of being out of the reach of parental guidance and families. Bearing in mind the diverse culture and traditions across the continent, we believe that the period they have spent in Nigeria studying was worth the while as they have also seized the opportunity to enhance integration and networking with one another making them a well-rounded person. We believe that all their fond memories will continue even after departure to their various countries and globally. We also believe that they will continue to relate with their colleagues via the PAU Alumni association and continue to practice Ubuntu.


